Legal and Police Delivery Service Discussion

- Professional development

Felix and Nolting provided information regarding the transition with the upcoming retirement of Felix. Mastin and Kingbird described their vision related to building tribal relationships. Mastin and Nolting provided insight into the increase of prosecution cases. Council addressed questions and concerns with staff regarding the Legal and Police Delivery Service.
