Pursuant to due call and notice, a special meeting of the Bemidji Economic Development Authority (BEDA) of the City of Bemidji, Beltrami County, Minnesota, was held on Monday, November 21, 2011, at 8:20 p.m. in the Conference Room of City Hall, President Larson presiding.
