

CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

Special Work Session – June 27, 2016

Pursuant to due call and notice, a special work session of the City Council of the City of Bemidji, Beltrami County, Minnesota, was held on Monday, June 27, 2016, at 5:30 p.m. in the Conference Room of City Hall, Mayor Albrecht presiding.

Upon roll call, the following Councilmembers were declared present: Albrecht, Meehlhause, Hellquist, Johnson, Erickson, Larson Absent: Olson

Staff Present: City Manager Nate Mathews

Others Present: Beltrami County Environmental Services - Bruce Anspach, Aquatic Invasive Lake Technician; Friends of Lake Bemidji Association– Sydney Corrigan

Mayor Albrecht stated that the purpose of the work session was to hear a presentation regarding Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS). Anspach provided a comprehensive presentation and summary of the Beltrami County AIS program, reviewing inspection data at the landings on Lake Bemidji, the types of AIS the County is addressing, and the public education efforts underway in Beltrami County.

Motion by Hellquist, seconded by Erickson, to approve \$2,000 of Storm Utility funds to be provided to the Beltrami County AIS program to be used to extend inspection hours at one of the Bemidji city boat landings. Motion unanimously carried.
