

**CANVASSING BOARD
PROCEEDINGS
BEMIDJI, MINNESOTA
August 16, 2018**

Pursuant to due call and notice, the Bemidji City Council met as a Canvassing Board on Thursday, August 16, 2018, at 5:15 p.m. in the Chambers at City Hall with Mayor Albrecht presiding.

Upon roll call, the following Canvassing Board members were declared present: Albrecht, Meehlhause, Hellquist, Johnson, Erickson, Larson. Absent: Lehmann

Staff Present: City Manager Nate Mathews, City Clerk Michelle Miller

Mayor Albrecht stated that the purpose of the meeting was to canvass the returns of the August 14, 2018 Primary Election for the At Large Council position and to certify the results.

Mayor Albrecht reviewed the results stating that 1,555 votes were cast. Jim Thompson received 485 votes, Lawrence Hanenberger received 336 votes and Don Heinonen received 569 votes.

Council moved to accept the results of the August 14, 2018 Primary Election, declaring Jim Thompson and Don Heinonen the winners and will be on the ballot for the 2018 General Election.

The City Clerk was directed to certify the results of the Election to the County Auditor (election results attached).
