Emergency Shut-off Switch	Warning Signs
"EMERGENCY FUEL SHUTOFF"	1. No Smoking.
	2. Shut off motor.
Emergency Procedures	3. Discharge your static electricity before fueling by touching a metal surface
IN CASE OF FIRE, SPILL OR RELEASE:	away from the nozzle.
1. USE EMERGENCY PUMP SHUT-OFF	4. To prevent static charge, do not reenter your vehicle while gasoline is pumping.
2. REPORT THE ACCIDENT!	5. If a fire starts, do not remove nozzle back away immediately.
3. FIRE DEPARTMENT TELEPHONE NUMBER	6. It is unlawful and dangerous to dispense gasoline into unapproved containers
4. FACILITY ADDRESS	7. No filling of portable containers in or on a motor vehicle. Place container on
	ground before filling.
