The Parks and Recreation Commission meet the second Tuesday of each month at 4:30p.m. The meetings are held at the Historic Carnegie Library located at 426 Bemidji Ave N.

Commission Member Terms

The Commission is composed of seven members who serve staggered three-year terms. Each commission member must reside within the corporate limits of the City of Bemidji.

What do I do as Parks Commission Member?

Duties

The Parks and Recreation Commission is an advisory board to the city council and city manager on matters relating to parks and trails including:

- Plan and develop programs and activities.
- Develop schedules of hours and fees for the use of recreational trails and park facilities.
- Study possible government and private foundation grants available for the acquisition and development of park and trail facilities.
- Develop plans for improvement and betterment of existing facilities.
- Develop plans for acquisition of additional facilities.
- Coordinate recreational trail and park activities with other community organizations and groups.
- Promote public interest and understanding of the city's parks and trails activities.
