

City of Bemidji Utility Service Cut Information – September 27, 2012

Commercial & Multi – Family Homes (See attachment for Typical Section and Overview). A \$5,000 Performance Bond will be required for this utility work in the city right-of-way.

Street Closure – Detour Required (Contractor is required to conform to the current edition of the MMUTCD on all traffic control zone layouts, including the current temporary traffic control zone layouts field manual). The Contractor is required to provide a detour plan to be reviewed and approved by Engineering before the work is to be done. The Contractor will provide all of the required signs, flashers, barricades and barrels necessary for the detour at his own expense.

Sidewalk Closure – If concrete sidewalk is removed, this will need to be closed and barricaded. When necessary, a detour route will be provided for pedestrians.

Patch Area Specifications – All bituminous edges will be sawn and tack coated. Both sub grade and aggregate base will be compacted. Bituminous will be placed in two lifts (each lift rolled and compacted). All removed bituminous material will be disposed of properly and at the contractor's expense. If any concrete material is removed it will be replaced and match the existing concrete in place. All removed concrete material will be disposed of properly and at the contractor's expense.

Time Line – Patch areas, curb & gutter, and sidewalks will be completed within 14 calendar days once work commences.

Inspection – Engineering will be notified 24 hours ahead of time, so an inspection can be completed on the service patch area. This will be done before the placement of bituminous is started.
