**DOMESTIC VIOLENCE INFORMATION**

IF YOU ARE THE VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, you can ask the city or county attorney to file a complaint. You have the right to notification if prosecution of the case is decline or criminal charges are dismissed. You also have the right to go to court and file a petition requesting an ORDER FOR PROTECTION from domestic abuse which could include the following:

1. An order restraining the abuser from further acts of abuse;
2. An order directing the abuser to leave your household;
3. An order preventing the abuser from entering your home (or a reasonable area around your home), school, business, or place of employment;
4. An order directing the abuser to pay support to you and the minor children if the abuser has a legal obligation to do so.
