

RIGHTS AND SERVICES FOR ALL CRIME VICTIMS

1. The right, if an offender is charged, to be informed of and participate in the prosecution process, including the right to request restitution (money court ordered from the offender and paid to the victim);
 2. The right to be notified of plea negotiations;
 3. The right to be present at plea hearings and sentencing and to object orally or in writing to a proposed plea agreement or sentence;
 4. The right to be notified of the final disposition of the case and any appeals;
 5. The right to request law enforcement keep your identity confidential from the public.
- The agency may comply if you are a victim of sexual assault or your personal safety or property is threatened.

Call the victim services providers listed in this card for information about other crime victim rights and services that may be available to you.

The initial notice of the rights of crime victims must be distributed by a peace officer to each victim, as defined in section 611A.01, at the time of initial contact with the victim. The notice must inform a victim of:

1. the victim's right to apply for reparations to cover losses, not including property losses, resulting from a violent crime and the telephone number to call to request an application;
2. the victim's right to request that the law enforcement agency withhold public access to data revealing the victim's identity under section 13.82, subdivision 17, paragraph (d);
3. the additional rights of domestic abuse victims as described in section 629.341.
